1. Antonia Fortress: Pilate condemns Jesus.
 2. Lithostrotos: Jesus receives the Cross.
 3. Jesus falls under the weight of the Cross.
 4. Mary sees Jesus with the Cross.
 5. Simon of Cyrene is forced to carry the Cross.
 6. Veronica wipes Jesus' face.
 7. Jesus falls a second time.
 8. Jesus speaks to the women of Jerusalem.
 9. Jesus falls a third time.
 10. Calvary: Jesus is stripped of His garments.
 11. Calvary: Jesus is nailed to the Cross.
 12. Calvary: Jesus dies on the Cross.
 13. Calvary: Jesus' body is taken from the Cross.
 14. Holy Sepulchre: Jesus' body is laid in the Tomb of Joseph of Arimathea.
